At the outset the Chairman welcomed the members of the P.G. Council and following resolutions were unanimously passed after threadbare discussions.

- 1. International M.Phil and Ph.D students will not be admitted in the academic session 2022-23 due to shortage of supervisors. However, P.G. students will be admitted on merit subject to an upper limit of 10% over and above the seat strength. The concerned Dept. will send its recommendation on the eligibility of the applicants to the Chairman, P.G. Council by 10.05.2022 for further action.
- 2. The courses of 4th Semester P.G. will be completed by 15th July 2022 and semester end examination will be completed by 31st July 2022 as per Govt. Notification.
- 3. On the basis of request of Course Coordinator, the sanctioned seats in MBA(Rural Management) may be increased from 16 to 24 with effect from academic session 2021-22. The proposal may be placed before the Academic Council.

- 4. Odisha Higher Education Council will be moved for imparting training to faculty and research scholars for optimum use of e-resources.
- 5. The P.G. (Regular and Self-financing) Dept. may send the details of students who are eligible for refund of course fee for the academic session, 2021-22 by 15th May 2022.
- 6. P.G. Council Hall usage charges will be exempted for the University official functions/regular P.G. Departments' seminars/meeting without sponsorship. For meeting/seminar organized by other users and P.G. Departments with sponsorship, the usage charge is fixed at Rs. 1,000/- per Day.
