The P.G. Council meeting was presided over by Chairman, P.G. Council and the following decisions were unanimously passed.

1. That M.Phil Entrance Test for the session 2021-22 will be conducted on Dt. 16.11.2021 as per the following schedule.

- Date of Entrance Test : 16.11.2021
- 1<sup>st</sup> Sitting (11.00 A.M to 12.00 Noon): paper-I: Research Methodology (50 questions)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Sitting (12.30 P.M. to 01.30 P.M): paper-II: Domain Subject (50 Questions)

N.B. The Qualifying mark for M.Phil is resolved to be 50% of the Entrance Tests. However, for SC/ST students it will be 45%.

Career Marks: 30

Viva voce Marks: 20

2. That Ph.D Entrance for the session 2021-22 will be conducted on 17.11.2021 as per the following schedule:

- Date of Entrance Test: 17.11.2021
- 1<sup>st</sup> Sitting (11.00 A.M. to 12.00 Noon): paper-I: Research Methodology (40 Questions)

- 2nd Sitting (12.30 P.M. to 01.30 P.M) : Domain Subject (40 Questions)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Sitting: For subjects specified (03.30 P.M. to 04.30 P.M) Paper-II : Multi-Disciplinary Subjects (40 Questions)

N.B: (a) The Full marks of Research Methodology and Domain Subjects would be 40 each. Viva marks will be 20.

(b) The qualifying mark would be 40%. For SC/ST candidates it would be 35% of the Entrance Test.

3. That Reservation Policy as per Government Rule will be maintained in the admission of M.Phil./Ph.D. Courses. They are as follows:

For ST : 22.5%

SC : 16.25%

PH : 5%

N.B: The reserved category candidates who would be selected on the basis of merit, they will be positioned as per their merit, but not in the group of reserved category candidates. However, they will be entitled for other assistance and benefits of the Govt. provision.

4. That the theory paper examinations of ongoing M.Phil. Courses will be conducted by December 2021.
5. That Dissertations of the ongoing M.Phil. Courses will be submitted by the students on or before March 2022.
6. That all HoDs will submit the 60 MCQ Questions with Answer Key (in soft copy) of their domain subjects i.e. Paper-II of M.Phil./Ph.D. Entrance Tests by 27<sup>th</sup> October 2021 to the Controller of Examinations.
7. That Internal (Mid-Semester Tests) of P.G. Second Semester will be completed by 06<sup>th</sup> November 2021 so that the third Semester could commence w.e.f. 08<sup>th</sup> November 2021.
8. That keeping in view of Academic Calendar under the COVID-19 pandemic situation, and UGC Guidelines on Examinations an alternative method of Examination for P.G. 2<sup>nd</sup> and Integrated Courses (2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> ) of Regular Examinations, 2021 are exempted from appearing the respective Semester End Examinations.

As per the said UGC Guideline, Examination Sub-Clause-5, "grading of the students could be composite of 50% marks on the basis of the pattern of Internal evaluation adopted by Universities and the remaining 50% marks can be awarded on the basis of performances in previous Semester only".

This proposal is passed.
