BIO SKETCH

Dr. Kabita Das is an Assistant Professor of Philosophy at the Department of Philosophy, Utkal University, Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India. She received her M.Phil and PhD degrees in Philosophy from the Centre for Philosophy, JNU, New Delhi, in 2010 and 2014, respectively, under the supervision of Prof. R.P. Singh. She joined the Odisha Education Service (OES) in 2013. Her research focuses on Normative Ethics, Applied Ethics, Socio-Political Philosophy, and Philosophy of Education, with particular emphasis on Virtue Ethics, Justice, Education and Environmental Ethics. She has published 31 research articles and book chapters in reputed journals, ed. books and anthologies. In 2020, she authored a paper titled “International social lockdown versus medical care against COVID-19, a mild environmental insight with special reference to India,” published in STOTEN by Elsevier, which is indexed in Web of Science and has an impact factor of 10.75. Recently, she authored an article in Telematics and Informatics Reports by Elsevier, which is indexed in Scopus and has an impact factor of 4.7. She has presented numerous research papers at national and international conferences and has served as an observer and rapporteur at several of these events. Additionally, she is a reviewer for two international journals and an editorial board member of the Athens Journal of Philosophy, Greece.
