Besides the physical impact, the psychological consequences of safety protocols during the pandemic have made matters worse. It has been realized since long that human dignity and mental health are interrelated. While disregard and discrimination meted out to people having mental health issues violate their right to life with dignity, the loss of intrinsic worth of an individual embedded in societal structure and cultural practices results in mental health issues. The recent pandemic saw hospitals being ill-equipped to address the stress and anxiety of patients and their family during different phases of the treatment. The need to access counselling and other mental health services across different age groups has been acutely felt during this time. Whether it is the traumatic isolation or the abject poverty, the loss of human dignity has been appalling. The situation seems to linger without any end in sight. It has been opined that the best way to cope with the situation is not to wait for the pandemic to end, rather learn to accept the prevailing circumstances as the 'New Normal'.

This calls for rethinking and reevaluating our role in ensuring human dignity as well as making mental health a priority across time and context. To deliberate upon the changing interpersonal dynamics, this International Conference intends to bring together academics, practitioners, social activists, students and the like from Psychology and related disciplines. The aim is to disseminate the current perspectives on the theme and related issues, and translate the shared meanings into social action for a stronger foothold of mental health in future research, policy and practices.
