At the outset Registrar, Utkal University welcomed Prof. A.K. Das, Vice Chancellor, Utkal University to the Academic Council. He also welcomed all the members and the invitees to the Academic Council.

Item No. 1                      Introductory address by the Vice Chancellor, Prof. A.K. Das  
( Chairman, Academic Council, Utkal University )

Prof. A.K. Das, Vice Chancellor in his inaugural address briefed the members about various activities of the University as noted below:

- This would be his last meeting of the Academic Council as he would complete his three year term in June, 2017 and he thanked all the members for the excellent support extended to him for the Academic Excellence of the University.
- He congratulated the efforts of the Academic Council and the teachers of the University whose effort has resulted in excellent placement record of the students

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During last three years. He appreciated the efforts of the placement cell of University. In particular he congratulated the successful candidates of various service examinations and Odisha Judiciary Service.

- He placed on record the appreciation of the University fraternity for the support of Govt. of Odisha for initiating a Civil Service Coaching Centre open to all candidates. He also informed the House that the University would very soon start a free Civil Service Coaching Centre in collaboration with a trust. He also appreciated the efforts of Ambedkar Study Centre for the success of SC/ST students in Civil Service Examinations.
- He congratulated the University fraternity for NAAC Accreditation with A+ grade. He felt that without the unstinted support of all stakeholders it would not have been possible to achieve such great success.
- He noted with great satisfaction the introduction of CBCS system at the +3 level in the affiliated colleges w.e.f. 2016-17. He thanked the Director, College Development Council and Controller of Examinations for their efforts in implementing the Academic reform.
- He informed the House about MoUs with Government & Public Corporate Bodies like CIPET, NALCO and LIGNITE Corporation under proposed Institutional Development Programme.
- He informed the House about the proposals for opening of three new programmes, namely : Master in Environmental Science, Master in Social Work & courses in Physical Education and Sports.
- He outlined the development regarding formation of Institutional Development Plan both for the University and number of affiliated colleges and appreciated the efforts of Prof. S.K. Tripathy, Director, College Development Council.
- He informed the House that it is proposed to allow Retired Teachers up-to the age of 70 yrs. to act as Research Guide and detailed proposal is included in the item.
- He also briefed the House about the development regarding WiFi Campus through ERNET being co-ordinated by Prof. Sateesh Pradhan and Seed money for research by young faculty members being coordinated by Director, R&D.

Item No. 1 To consider the Proposal for opening a P.G. Course in Social Work at Utkal University.

Resolved that opening of courses in a P.G. Department is an administrative matter to be decided by the Chairman, P.G. Council / Director, SFS Courses and the Syndicate. Further Resolved that the Academic Council approves the syllabus for MSW proposed to be offered by the P.G. Dept. of Sociology.

Item No. 2 To consider the proposals in adherence to the provisions laid down under Clause (f) of Sub-Section (3) of Section (15) of the Odisha Universities Act, 1966 corresponding to Clause (g) of Sub-Section (2) of Section (12) of the Odisha Universities Act, 1989, relating to the Rules for Management of Parija Library and other libraries under the Utkal University and the same is approved by the V.C on 24.03.2017.

The proposal is approved subject to the following amendments that the Chief Librarian of Parija Library shall ensure annual stock

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verification and take steps for removal of obsolete titles periodically and shall report to the syndicate on action taken for these.

Item No. 3 i) To consider the following recommendation by the Dean, Faculty of Education and Director, DDCE, Utkal University regarding introduction of the B.Ed Secondary, M.Ed and Integrated B.A/B.Sc/B.Com B.Ed in the Centre for Teacher Education established at Utkal university under DDCE.

1. B.Ed/M.Ed/ Integrated B.A/B.Sc/B.Com B.Ed courses are to be in regular mode and not under Distance mode and the question of Distance mode to be considered after 2 years.
2. The syllabus for 2 years Secondary B.Ed/ 2 years M.Ed programme shall be same as developed by SCERT, Government of Odisha and implemented by Board of Studies, Education, Utkal University. However additional elective skill components shall be offered.
3. The Integrated B.A/B.Sc/B.Com B.Ed shall have two components. A B.Ed component which will cover the syllabi of B.Ed Secondary vide.2. The structure is annexed. The Teacher Council of the Centre for Teacher Education shall act as the Board of studies for the courses offered by the Centre. The Principal, RNIASE, Cuttack, The Principal, RIE, Bhubaneswar and Director, DDCE shall be ex-officio members. This shall be implemented under approval of the Syndicate.
4. All the courses shall be under CBCS system and necessary modifications in the structure shall be placed in the Regulation Amending Committee by Director, DDCE for approval.

Resolved that the proposal be approved.

ii) To consider the recommendations of Director, DDCE for minor modification in the Syllabus of various P.G. Courses under the faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences and Management Programme, with the introduction of two new groups namely Agri Business and Good Governance under MBA and P.G. Diploma in Management, being offered by DDCE, Utkal University .

Resolved that the proposal be approved.

Item No. 4 To consider the matter relating to the introducing basic IT Skill Certificate Course received from the Govt. of Odisha, Higher Education Department vide letter No. 7970 HE/ dated 27.03. 2017.

Resolved that the basic IT certificate courses offered through Spoken Tutorial of IIT, Bombay may be offered by various affiliated colleges as non-credit courses .

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Item No. 5

To consider the minor modifications in the CBCS Syllabus of various P.G. Departments and Sponsored Courses

**A. New Ph.D & M.Phil Regulation**

The RAC recommends to the Academic Council the approval of the MHRD- UGC Notification New Delhi, the 5<sup>th</sup> May 2016 University Grant Commission (Minimum Standard and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degrees) Regulations, 2016 {In supersession of the UGC (Minimum Standard and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D Degree) Regulation, 2009, notified in The Gazette of India [No. 28, Part- III- Section 4] for the week July 11, July 17, 2009) with the following exceptions and additional provisions;

- That the Department may assign Ph.D and M.Phil scholars to retired teachers of the University subject to the condition that the respective dept agrees to extend necessary facilities and resources for the research work both to the scholar and the supervisor. Such teacher will be known as honorary faculty.
- that the Honorary faculty agrees to accept some teaching assignments, in the dept on mutual consultation and agreement with the Teacher Council of the Dept;
- that the Honourary faculty is not above the age of 65 years so that the entire process of research work and examination is completed within the age limit 70 years of the supervisor;
- that the limitation of number of scholars **as per UGC guideline** shall be applicable to such retired teachers as per their rank and designation at the time of superannuation;
- that the number of M.Phil seats shall be confirmed at the present limit in each department.
- that the URC (University Research Committee) shall continue to discharge its responsibilities and act as a body of policy makers regarding Research work **that the URC in disposing of the case of any individual case of scholar shall consider the opinion of respective Chairman, SRC** and that the new regulations be made effective from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2017.
- That the SRC system shall continue to operate and shall also act as the Doctoral Research Committee for the individual candidates;
- That the SRC may invite experts to its meeting to meet the needs of individual scholars.
- The Vice Chancellor is authorized to lay down the policy for prevention of plagiarism in the Doctoral and Post Doctoral Research Work and relating to publication of articles , research papers and books etc. by the faculty of the University or any other author under affiliation to Utkal University ( such as scholars and teachers of affiliated colleges).

**B. Waiver Scheme**

- That the waivers scheme of 8 years limitations be extended to all those who were registered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> June 2005 **(the date of issuance of the letter of registration shall be considered to be the date of registration)**. However, no re registration shall be allowed and no change of guide shall be allowed even in case of death. No change of title shall be allowed.

7. The application from individuals obtaining degrees from different universities outside Odisha seeking equivalence were taken up for necessary report was prepared on all those applications.

Revision of Syllabus of MA Psychology, Utkal University: The syllabus was modified according to recent trends in the discipline with the help of external experts Prof Naniita Mohanty and Prof Pratap K. Rath during January 2021. In Specialization papers (Paper 11 & 12) of Counselling Psychology and Human Resource Psychology, current practices or recent trends such as online mode of functioning was added to each unit. Inclusion of virtual mode in Internship (Paper 17 & 18) and Field Visit (Paper 16) is made. In Social Psychology (Paper 4), the scope of Health Psychology is enhanced. In Educational Psychology (Paper 7), New Education Policy 2020 and Disability issues is added in Unit 4.

As per directive of PG Council, Utkal University, changes in Total Credit and Total Marks were made as 100 and 2000 respectively for uniformity among Arts discipline in PG Courses of Utkal University. Two Swayam online Courses were included in the third semester. Paper 15 Film appreciation was brought to fourth semester. Paper 5: Statistics, SPSS & Computer Application was made 6 credits as it has practical component. Internship was made 100 marks but credit remaining 8 as before.

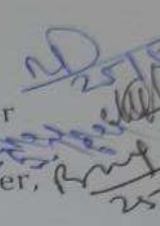

As a result we will have the freedom to start new courses, off-campus centres, research parks, skill development courses, enter into academic collaborations with other institutions and other academic programmes.
- While placing the academic agenda for next three years the Vice Chancellor said " during 2018-19, we will admit students in the subjects of M.Sc./ M.A, Public Health, MBA in Rural Management, Master in Social Work, Bachelor in Education ( 2 years ) and Master in Education (2 years) in our new campus at Siha, Chandikhole in the district of Jajpur and in next two years we shall make the campus towards rural societies in general and villages, in particular, oriented with more courses on skill development, art & culture, heritage and handicrafts, etc.
- He also stated that Utkal University has plans for establishing an International Collaboration Centre as a step forward for making it a world class University
- At the end he invited suggestions and opinions from members and Registrar moved with other agenda.

### **Business Transacted**

**University theme song was played as opening song and members stood paying respect. Sri Dayanidhi Nayak, Registrar requested the Vice Chancellor to address the session.**

The Vice Chancellor welcomed all the members present in the meeting and requested for deliberations and discussion. In his address, he emphasized the role of the Academic Council, the highest Academic Body of the University, that directs the academic activities of the University and other stake holders for the coming year. It is an annual exercise carried out by the University every year. The quality of the deliberations should be of high standard which reflects the intellectual brilliancy of our teachers in the tune of academic policy of the UGC for academic up-liftment of the state as well as the whole country. He emphasized on the following four points;

- i. Utkal University in association with other universities of the state and with the active co-operation of Odisha State Higher Education Council (OSHEE) took the lead role in preparing a UG Model Syllabus as per UGC guidelines for all universities of Odisha which will be implemented from the year 2019-20. In

connection with this, a series of meeting of all the Vice Chancellors, all the Controller of Examinations of the Universities of Odisha and the Board of Studies in all disciplines was held. External subject experts from different universities outside Odisha were contacted from time to time for their academic input by the Vice Chairman, Odisha State Higher Education Council, Bhubaneswar.

- ii. The Vice Chancellor informed the august House that MHRD, Government of India 's RUSA Programme and Odisha Government's World Bank Programme have earmarked certain funds which will be earmarked for academic enrichment including teachers' training programme. These short term programmes can be organized by the College Development Council and Controller of Examinations. For this a proposal can be presented by the teachers or Director, College Development Council. While submitting the proposal non bureaucratic approach should be ensured to improve the academic climate of the College.
  - iii. The affiliated College teachers who are eligible as per UGC guidelines can also act as guide of the scholars for Ph.D Programmes. However, the Colleges teachers should apply for this through the respective Head of the Post Graduate Departments to the Controller of Examinations for its approval by the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) and University Research Committee (URC) / BOS / Vice Chancellor..
  - iv. University intends to adopt some colleges / village in remote rural areas to share the knowledge and research gains which will ultimately serve the society at large through RUSA.

  3. Election to the Senate from the Academic Council is deferred as no member has applied.
  - 4.. Proceedings of the Meeting of the Equivalence Committee held on 21.05.2019 was approved.

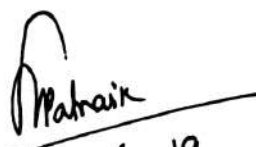
