PROCEEDINGS OF THE TEACHERS' COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 04.01.2017

The teachers' Council of the department met on 04 January 2017 at 3.00 P.M. in the department with Dr. H. S. Rout, HOD in chair.

The Council resolved the following:

1. Special efforts need to be taken to reduce diversity in the academic performance across students at master's level and to enhance their abilities. Dr. A. R Behera, based on the results of last semester, has already identified and grouped the students into three categories such as Group-A: Achievers / Gifted / Advanced Learners (score more than 80 percent), Group-B: Average Performers (60-80 percent scoring) and Group-C: Slow Learners (students with less than 60 percent score and having at least one paper failed). It was observed that in the admission batch 2016-17, there are 11 students in group A, 40 students in group-B and 28 students in Group-C. The following activities were planned for improving the academic performance of students.
2. The activity plan to be undertaken before May 2017.

3	Group-C	In addition to the activities listed for Group-B, the students under Group-C will be called for one -to-one discussions with their respective mentors and specific problems related to their performance could be identified and efforts to be taken by mentors with support from others to address those.
