## Business transacted

- 1. Proceedings of the last meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2021 was confirmed.
- 2. Members were welcomed by Prof. Pravati Kumari Mahapatra, Director, IQAC. Prof. Mahapatra presented the action taken report of the previous IQAC committee meeting as under:
  - Academic Audit of all departments/centre was conducted during 28th and 29th
  - ii. Uploading information for NIRF-2022 India Ranking was completed on 7th Feb., 2022
  - iii. Institutional Information for Quality Assurance (IIQA)for third cycle NAAC accreditation was submitted on 14th February, 2022 and subsequent quarries of NAAC were met on 12th March and 22nd March, 2022.
  - iv. The recommendation given by the committees of Green and Environment, Gender, Energy and Water audits were discussed and intimated to University ammonization for necessary action.
  - v. A meeting of Conveners of different criteria of SSR was held on 25th February, 2022 to evaluate progress on preparation of SSR. Another review meeting of all

conveners and members of seven criteria was held on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 to evaluate status of SSR.

- vi. Administrative audit was conducted by the Registrar.
- vii. Implementation of e-office in the University is in progress under the supervision of the office of the Registrar.

- Prof Bhaswati Patnaik suggested for documentation of best practices of all departments.
- Prof. Nigamananda Das proposed for creating a better eco-friendly campus and developing gender neutral facilities. He further suggested preparing brief bio-sketch of all former faculty members of university (department wise) and uploading the same on the University website.
