Brief History of the Department

Utkal University:

Utkal University, founded in 1943, is among the premier universities of the country. Spread over 400 acres of land, it is located on the National Highway No.5 at Bhubaneswar. Besides the affiliated colleges and institutions, it has 27 constituent Post-Graduate teaching departments; two amongst them enjoy the status of Advanced Centres and some of them are Departments of Special Assistance and Research Support. The departments offer M.A., M. Phil. and Doctoral courses. Parija Library, its central library, has more than two lakh books and subscribes to nearly 400 journals. Each and every department cater to the needs of Post Graduate students and research scholars. It has a large auditorium and several other conference halls. Excellence in teaching and research is the motto of all the Post-Graduate Departments and Centres of the University.

The Post-Graduate Department of History was founded on 1st December 1959 at the then Ravenshaw College, Cuttack. It was shifted to Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar in July 1962 when the University moved to its present premises from Cuttack. Ever since the Department is functioning in the Old Arts Block of the University. One among the two largest departments, it functions at present as an autonomous Department of Learning and Research. The output of research in the Department, both in the qualitative and quantitative sense, has also got due recognition by the community of scholars and academics all around. The University hence, has accorded it the status of an autonomous Department since January 1995. The Department has successfully celebrated the Golden Jubilee Year of its foundation during the session 2009-10.



Prof. Mrs Jayanti Dora has graduated with First Class Honours with Distinction and was selected for the award of National Scholarship. She was all along a first-class student from HSC to M.Phil and was placed in the Best Tenth at the Graduate and Postgraduate stages. She was awarded Ph.D. Degree from Sambalpur University in recognition of her research work on Sakta Monuments of Orissa (From Early Times to the 13th century AD.), She started her career as a lecturer in the Dept of History, at Utkal University, Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar. At present, she is Professor and Head in the same Department. Her field of specialization are Socio-Cultural Diversities in India, Regional History and Heritage (Odisha), Historiography and Methodology and also Gender Studies. She is also Director of School of Women's Studies, Director of the Centre of Excellence, North East Indian Studies and a Syndicate Member of Utkal University. She is a life member of Professional bodies like the Odisha/ Indian History Congress, Indian Association for Asian and Pacific Studies, Indian Art History Congress, Indian History Culture and Society, ASSR and many others. She has completed a UGC Major Research Project titled "Prospect of Cultural Tourism in Western Orissa: A Study on Heritage Sites". She has published three books and about 50 articles in different reputed National and International Journals. She has produced 08 Ph D scholars and 30 M. Phil scholars under her able guidance. TEACHING PROGRAMME:

Admissions to M.A., M. Phil and Ph.D. courses are given on the basis of academic career of the candidates and marks secured in Entrance Tests.

M.A.:

The Department has introduced a new and updated syllabus with emphasis on specialisation in different branches of History, scrupulously adhering to the need of the region and the imperative of strengthening teaching and research in History against the backdrop of the latest academic developments in History in India and abroad.

Since 2004-05, the Department has introduced **Semester System** with two semesters each every year. The Choice based Credit System has been introduced in the department since 2013-14.

M. Phil.:

Introduced in the Department in 1978, the M. Phil. course prepares the students for acquiring research skills as well as new research methods and theories of History. The M. Phil scholars are required to appear at the Semester examinations in three theory papers carrying 100 marks each. In Paper IV, each student is required to prepare a Dissertation under the guidance of a teacher of the Department. Since 2008, the Department has introduced Semester system for M. Phil. students consisting of two Semesters.

Ph.D.:

The Department conducts Ph.D. Coursework Programme in History in accordance with the guidelines prepared by the University.

Seminar Library and other Facilities:

Besides Parija Library of the University, there is also a Seminar Library for the exclusive use of the students and teachers of the Department. The Department has a good collection of maps and charts.

There is an **Archival Cell**. It has preserved a few records of historical importance.

The Department conducts annual **study tours** to different historic places of India and Odisha. Besides, there is provision of field study for M. Phil. and History of Odisha special paper students.

There is a Seminar called **History Seminar** in the Department and all the students, teachers, research scholars and fellows are its members. It organises seminars, symposia, discussions, paper readings etc. regularly. Besides, distinguished scholars belonging to various branches of History (both Indian and Foreign) are invited to the Seminar from time to time to deliver lectures for benefit of the students and scholars.
