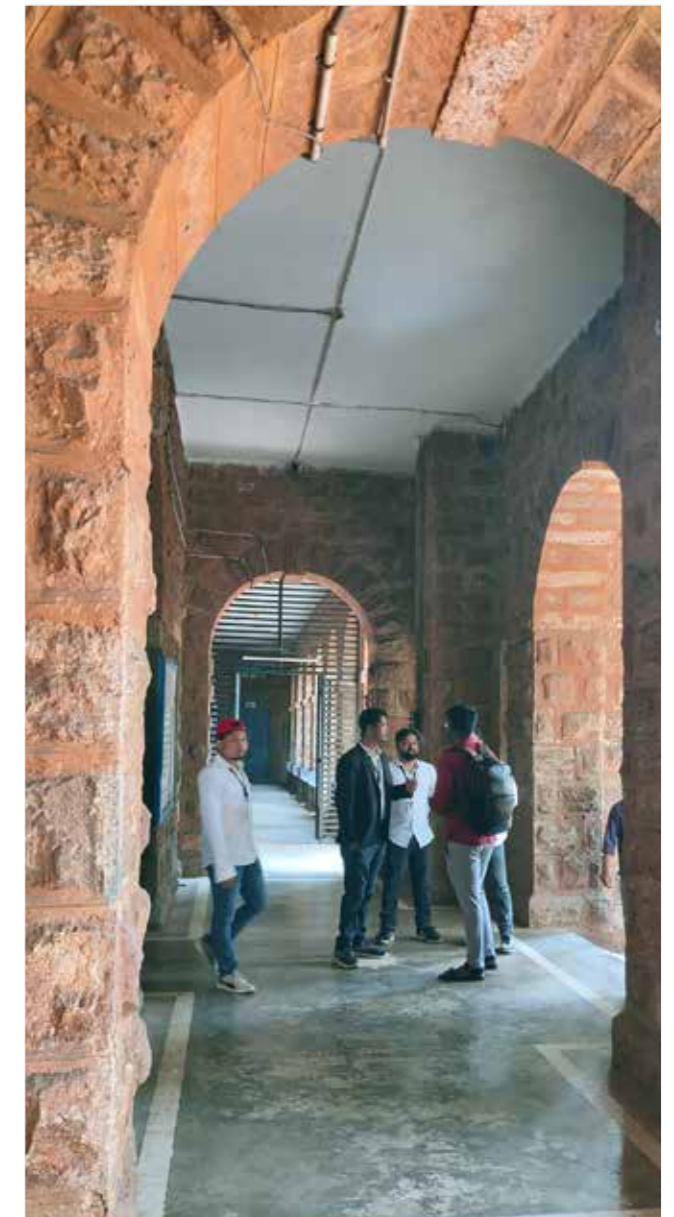

PLACES VISITED & LAW

The Study Tour Team discussed with the teacher guide regarding application of law to the places visited and various other legal aspects.

01

Borra Caves

There is no specific laws exist in India to protect such natural limestone caves formed underground. However Article 49 of the constitution provides for protection of monuments and places and objects of national importance.

Specific laws need to be enacted to protect such natural caves.



02

Katika Waterfall

The waterfall situated in the Eastern Ghat mountains. The Place is accessible through the local tribal village and only Panchayat vehicles are allowed to access the waterfall from the main road with a fee of two hundred rupees, which is contributing to the economy of villagers.

03

Araku Valley

The valley is situated in Eastern Ghat, which is protected by The Environment Protection Act, 1986, Wild Life Protection Act, 1972, Forest Conservation Act, 1980, Biological Diversity Act, and UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC)





04

Kailasagiri

Doppler Weather Radar Station on the hilltop of Kailasagiri, monitors cyclones in the Bay of Bengal. This is as per provisions of The Disaster Management Act, 2005. The Act provides effective management of disasters.

05

Simhachalam

The entrance of the hill has a signboard which bars any vehicle carrying symbols of other religions from entering. It may be challengeable as violative of fundamental rights under Constitution and ethos of secularism.



06

Submarine Kursura

The INS Kursura submarine museum offers a unique glimpse into maritime laws and naval technology of maritime security and international agreements ensuring responsible operation & usage of underwater vessels.



07

Rama Naidu Studio

It is one of the largest film production & distribution houses of India. Suresh Productions has produced more than 150 films in 13 languages. The award winning movies are copyright law protected in India.

08

Visakha Museum

The museum include ancient armory, crockery, coins, silk costumes, jewelry, stuffed animals, portraits, manuscripts, letters, diaries, scrap-books, periodicals, and maps. The maritime law applicable to sea travel.

Vizag Zoo

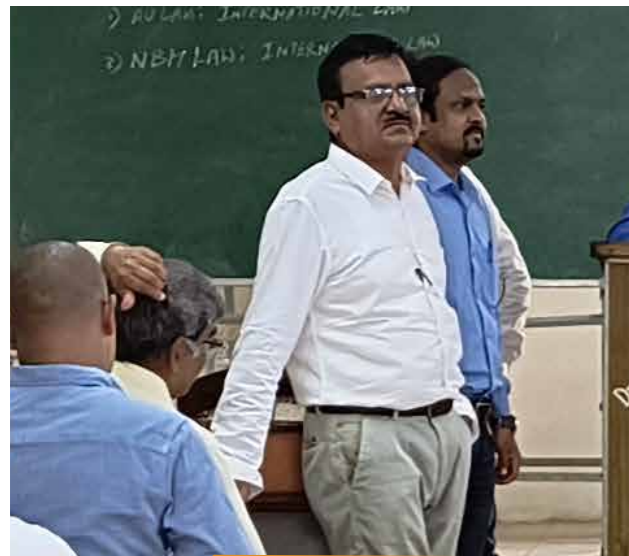
