In 1980, it was declared as a Centre of Advanced Study in Psychology (CASP), the first such centre in Psychology in the country, and the only such centre in Odisha. The department has had the CAS status for 29 years. The faculties have contributed to the growth of the discipline through innovative research as well as towards the mental health needs of the community since long. The Department recently celebrated its Diamond Jubilee at Utkal University.
